



Every dollar goes to Kirra

A BULLETIN report stated ‘the Government is attempting to wriggle out of its \$1.5 million pledge to bring back the world-renowned point break’ (Breaking point for vow to aid Kirra, *GCB* October 13).

Nothing could be further from the truth. What I made clear at the weekend was that the storms have helped us do the job – they have not done the job for us.

As a result of the large amounts of sand removed from Kirra by the storms this year, stage two has required a re-assessment.

We plan to work with key stakeholders such as Kirra Point Inc to determine the best course of action in the short term so we can capitalise

on the assistance received from Mother Nature.

We are committed to developing a sand dune system at the back of Kirra as planned this year.

Also, a long-term solution to ensure sand saturation does not occur again is in the best interests of both the community and the environment.

Contrary to what your report states, the Bligh Government is committed to fully applying the \$1.5 million allocated for Kirra beach.

Not one dollar of the \$1.5 million will be spent on another project.

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
